Los Ranchitos RE Overview

In April 2023, Realtor.com updated their information on the housing market and included our lovely community of Los Ranchitos. As per Realtor.com the median listing home price in Los Ranchitos was \$1.9M in April 2023, trending up 44% year-over-year. The median listing home price per square foot was \$529. What they didn't mention is that they included the "Active-Listings" within the Santiago Estates community which there are four currently on the market for sale.

Los Ranchitos is attractive because of all the amenities close by. You can find dozens of grocery stores, and hundreds of cafes and restaurants within a 15-minute drive from our cozy Los Ranchitos community.

Our specific Los Ranchitos community (excluding Santiago Estates), currently has a median price of \$1,431,105 which is still outstanding. For those who have purchased their home not too long ago they are sitting on some hefty equity. Currently there are only two homes for sale in our community 30433 Cabrillo at \$1,459,000, and 30955 De Portola at \$1,800,000. Homes in our community have sold for much more just a short time ago and I believe the prices will be going back up in the near future as the demand for homes is greater than the supply.

Everyone loves our Los Ranchitos community. The horse improved properties seem to always sell faster and at higher prices and that is because Los Ranchitos was designed for the equestrian families with larger home lots and the horse trails throughout the community. Getting national attention from Realtor.com is beneficial to the property owners and we should be very proud to be living in and part of this great community.

Park N Ride

- ♦ Masonry wall & DG trail complete.
- ♦ Horse trail fencing is part of the adjacent parcel development agreement.

La Paz St to Temecula Parkway

- ♦ The City is adding a 2nd right hand turn lane from La Paz.
- May be part of the Hospital project or Gateway project.

Gateway Development

- ♦ Parcel 2 proposal from Panera Bread—in preliminary stages.
- ♦ LA Fitness proposal change to a Pickleball Center—in preliminary stages.

Temecula Pkwy/Vallejo Development

- Developer has secured interest by an anchor tenant.
- ◆ Developer is putting together conceptual design and circulation. Design presentation is not yet scheduled.

Temecula Hospitality

- City is awaiting payment from developer for the traffic signal at Wabash Road in order to approve permits for the Vallejo Road improvement including the Horse Trail and landscaping.
- ◆ The developer <u>may</u> ask LRHOA to increase the size of the Dunkin Donuts building.
- ♦ Developer needs to complete its obligation to Dunkin Donuts by Q1 2024.


Trail System:

Our trail system was designated for both horse and pedestrian use! Enjoy the ride or walk on our beautiful trails.

- The Trail Committee is made up of volunteers. They are your neighbors. Thank you to these wonderful volunteers!
- We are active in helping keep the trail system functional and enjoyable. If you see a problem or have a suggestion feel free to contact any member or the property manager.

2023 Projects:

- ◆ Installation of 4 additional trail head gates are needed to eliminate daily unauthorized driving on trails.
- Please, trail use by motorized vehicles is prohibited.
- ♦ Signage plan for the trails and trail head at each location—these signs will be posted at each trail crossing.
- ♦ Horse Crossing Plan. Status: 2 signalized crossing completed.
- ◆ The city will provide additional signalized and unsignalized crossing and striping at horse trail crossings.

Trail maintenance is a yearly process and we try to address trouble areas plus general maintenance. This maintenance is the largest budgeted cost annually for Los Ranchitos HOA.

Keep in mind your association dues only cover a small portion of the <u>actual</u> cost to groom the trails. Your LRHOA board has allocated some of the commercial property dues to help cover these costs as the trail represents one of the shining assets of our community.

The property owners who have trails on their property are responsible for all maintenance including but not limited to, trash removal, weeding, tree trimming, fencing and erosion damage to the trail system. If your tree falls into the trail you are responsible for the removal and repairs. The LRHOA will provide trail grooming on native soil as needed.

Your trails committee has been working closely with the contractor to maintain the trails. If you see a problem please report asap and we will get on it. If you see trash, please help by picking it up.
